CHARACTERISTICS

Our aluminum furniture is meticulously crafted through precise stretching and heat treatments. Electrostatic powder coating is applied to our aluminum furniture. It is important to take care of your aluminum products from chemicals used in gardens, fertilizers, high pH water for irrigation, and high salt content in coastal areas.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Furniture should be periodically cleaned thoroughly with a clean, soft cloth and soapy water. In coastal areas, furniture should be frequently washed and rinsed to remove salt deposits that may damage the finish. We recommend using a mild soap. When maintaining your aluminum furniture, rinse with water and dry with a soft cloth.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- To prevent water stains, avoid allowing water to accumulate or stand on the surface of your furniture. Dry it with a dry microfiber cloth.
- When moving your furniture, avoid dragging it along the floor.
- Use felt pads on the bottoms of objects that will remain on the tabletop for an extended period. This is particularly important for natural stone materials or items that retain moisture. Use coasters for beverages.
- We recommend using SNOC protective covers that are tailored to fit your furniture.
- When using protective covers, ensure that your furniture and cushions are clean and dry.
- When covering your furniture with a protective cover (for situations when the product will not be used for an extended period), if possible, remove the cushions.
- If the cushions get wet, ensure that all the water drains out by keeping the zipper facing downward and the zippers open while allowing them to dry.
