CHARACTERISTICS

Concrete products of SNOC are made from a specially designed concrete mixture. They are resistant to harsh weather conditions and have a non-porous nature with small pores.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Stained Areas

- Use a non-abrasive cleaner.
- Spray the cleaner onto the surface and let it sit for 2-3 minutes, then wipe it off with a sponge or soft cloth.
- For additional protection and polishing, use a concrete-specific sealant.

Comprehensive Cleaning

- Mix warm water with a mild soap and clean with a soft bristle brush
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners
- Rinse with water and dry with a soft cloth after the cleaning process.
- Powerful washing with 83 bar (1200 PSI) pressure is also effective. Keep the pressure washer approximately 30 cm away from the furniture.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Avoid placing or dragging sharp or hard objects along the surface to prevent scratches.
- Avoid contact with acidic substances that can damage the surface.
- We do not recommend using cleaning products that are typically highly acidic or most natural cleaners. Citrus-based cleaners should not be used.
- Do not use cleaning products that contain acetone or denatured alcohol.
- Avoid using abrasive or ammonia-based cleaners.
- We always recommend using coasters or placemats.
- Use felt pads on the bottoms of objects that will remain on the tabletop for an extended period. This is especially important for natural stone materials or products containing moisture.
- Quickly wipe up spills to prevent staining.
- SNOC furniture covers will help protect against external elements.
